**Educational Completions** 

- Electrical, Electronic, and Electromechanical Assemblers, Except Coil Winders, Tapers, and Finishers decreased by 6 from 2015-2020 (-7.4%), less than the national growth rate of 10.6%. The occupation is projected to decrease by 7 from 2020-2025 (-8.2%), less than the national projected growth rate of 4.2%.
- Regional job concentration per capita for Electrical, Electronic, and Electromechanical Assemblers, Except Coil Winders, Tapers, and Finishers is 1.10 times the national job concentration. In other words, there are 10% more Electrical, Electronic, and Electromechanical Assemblers, Except Coil Winders, Tapers, and Finishers in this region than we would expect to find in the average region.
- Cost of labor in the region is above median. The median earnings for Electrical, Electronic, and Electromechanical Assemblers, Except Coil Winders, Tapers, and Finishers in the region is \$17.81/hr, which is \$0.32/hr above the national median of \$17.49/hr.



### Occupation Age Breakdown





# **Appendix B - Data Sources and Calculations**

#### Institution Data

The institution data in this report is taken directly from the national IPEDS database published by the U.S. Department of Education's National Center for Education Statistics.

#### **Location Quotient**

Location quotient (LQ) is a way of quantifying how concentrated a particular industry, cluster, occupation, or demographic group is in a region as compared to the nation. It can reveal what makes a particular region unique in comparison to the national average.

#### **Occupation Data**

Emsi occupation employment data are based on final Emsi industry data and final Emsi staffing patterns. Wage estimates are based on Occupational Employment Statistics (QCEW and Non-QCEW Employees classes of worker) and the American Community Survey (Self-Employed and Extended Proprietors). Occupational wage estimates are also affected by county-level Emsi earnings by industry.
